Site Specific Rules & Instructions

Special Fish Care Rule: All Boats must have on board a "Fish Fizzer" Needle.

Please make every effort to care for your fish, use ICE, Fish Alive Treatment, and if needed Fish Fizzer.

4 Fish Limit per Team - 15" inch size limit. Start Time- 7:00am-

Check-in 3:00 pmAll boats in the water by 6:30, we can leave. During boat check, you will be given a chip with your boat number. Upon check-in, you will need to place the chip into a bucket located at the KBBC Trailer. Weigh-In opens at 3:30.**

Boats will be released / boat numbers will be called from the last boat in the flight that will be positioned near the entrance to Marina Bay. Proceed in order at NO WAKE speed until you exit marina bay and pass the No Wake Buoy. If you come in early, please notify a K.B.B.C. staff member listed below.

WEIGH -IN PROCEDURES: Once you have weighed your fish you must return your fish to your livewell and transport them to the Bay Channel before releasing. THE ONLY EXCEPTION, If you have all Largemouth's, you do NOT need to transport them back to the channel. **Do Not Take the weigh-in bag or Mesh Bag with you** - Return the Bags to the scales prior to transporting your fish to the Bay.

The K.B.B.C. Tournament Committee assumes that all participants have read and fully Understand All K.B.B.C TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS provided on tournament applications and listed on the K.B.B.C. web site www.kbass.com.

Fishing is permitted in the Presque Isle Bay and Lake Erie Weather Permitting. In the event of dangerous Wind & Wave Conditions the Tournament Committee may restrict the tournament waters to Bay Only. Should the Tournament be restricted to BAY ONLY NO FISHING & NO BOATS are permitted within the Chute Walls.

IF WE ARE RESTRICTED TO BAY ONLY THE TOURNAMENT CREEL LIMIT WILL BE INCREASED TO 6 FISH PER TEAM!!

OFF LIMIT AREAS

1. All Marina areas & Boat Docks.
2. 100 Feet of any public boat launch or dock.
3. ALL SWIMMING BEACHES
4. All Areas posted as No Fishing.

All Fish & Boat Commission, Coast Guard, Army Corp, and Local Park Laws Prevail and Must be adhered to at all times!
