# 6 Fish Limit per Team - 12" inch size limit.

Start Time- 7:00am- Check-in 3:00 pm. ALL Boats in H2o by 6:30, we will leave. \*Boat check. You will be given a chip with your boat number. \*See below.

## Weigh-in scales open at 3:30 pm

Boats will be released / boat numbers will be called from the last Boat. Please position your boat at the 1<sup>st</sup> bridge at the end of the "no wake" channel that enters the Allegheny River.

**Check-in.\* Place your chip into the bucket located at the KBBC Trailer.** If you come in early, please notify one of the KBBC Staff members listed below.

Do not pass any boat in the lock areas. Please use common sense and courtesy when adhering to this rule.

#### OFF LIMIT AREAS

1. 100 Feet of any public boat launch and public docks at boat launches.

2. Inside warning buoys at all Dams and Locks. No Boats Allowed, See Lock - Dam Rules Diagram.

All Fish & Boat Commission, Coast Guard, Army Corp, Laws Prevail and Must be

Adhered to at all times.

### Lock & Dam Rule

No boats are permitted beyond the Dam Warning Buoys at any lock or dam. However, Casting of baits beyond the line of the buoys is permitted. No casting baits is permitted in the inner walls of the lock chamber entrances. If the warning buoys are positioned below the **Shortest** lock wall the off limit line starts from the end of the long wall. If the warning buoys are positioned above the lock walls the off limit line starts from the end of the short wall.
